SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. LOCATION OF RACE OFFICE NOTICE BOARD AND FLAG POLE

- 1.1 The Race Office and Notice Board is located inside the PDYC Club House. The Flag Pole on which signals are made ashore is located at the front of PDYC club house.

2. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 2.1 When 2 races are scheduled on the same day, the 2nd race will start ASAP after the last boat finishes the previous race. AP will be displayed shortly after the 1st boat finishes the first race to indicate that there will be a second race on the day.

3. CLASS FLAGS

- Division 1 - Numeral pennant 1 (Backstay flag black)
 Division 2 - Numeral pennant 2 (Backstay flag white)
 Division 4 - Numeral pennant 4 (Backstay flag lime green)

- 3.1 Boats shall fly the provided backstay flag whilst racing. It shall be flown from the backstay or conspicuously from the stern.

4. COURSES

As per appendix A

- 4.1 Numbered boards indicating the course to be sailed will be displayed before or with the Warning Signal. This amends RRS 7.1.
 4.2 A barging buoy may be laid near the Start Vessel approximately on the starting line. Boats shall not pass between this buoy and the Start Vessel at any time.

5. MARKS

- 5.1 Mark A orange inflatable buoy.
 5.2 Marks 1, 2, 2S & 2P are orange inflatable buoys.
 5.3 Mark 3 is a yellow inflatable buoy.
 5.4 Snapper Island (SI) – approx. S16° 17' & E145° 29'
 5.5 Low Isles (LI) – approx. S16° 23' & E145° 34'
 5.6 Start/Finish Mark- Yellow inflatable buoy.

6. TIME LIMITS

- 6.1 The race time limits for each course are shown in appendix A.
6.2 RRS Appendix S Sailing Instruction 12.1 is changed to "Race Time Limit is the time limit for all boats to sail the course and finish".

7. SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 7.1 Check-In and Check-Out: Hail Start Boat. No radio use. [DP]
7.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible. [DP]
9.1 Unless in use, no part of any anchor may project forward of the bow at any time whilst racing. [DP]

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 8.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]
8.2 Competitors shall monitor VHF channel 72 for the duration of each race.

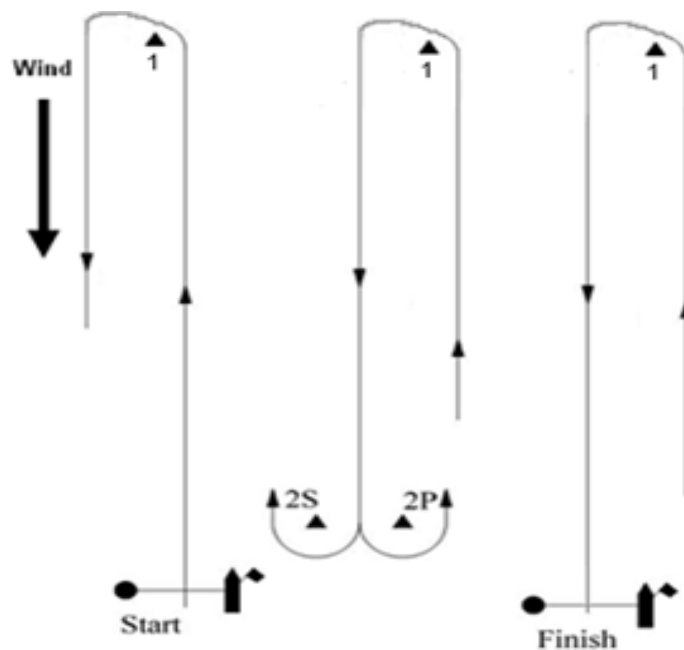

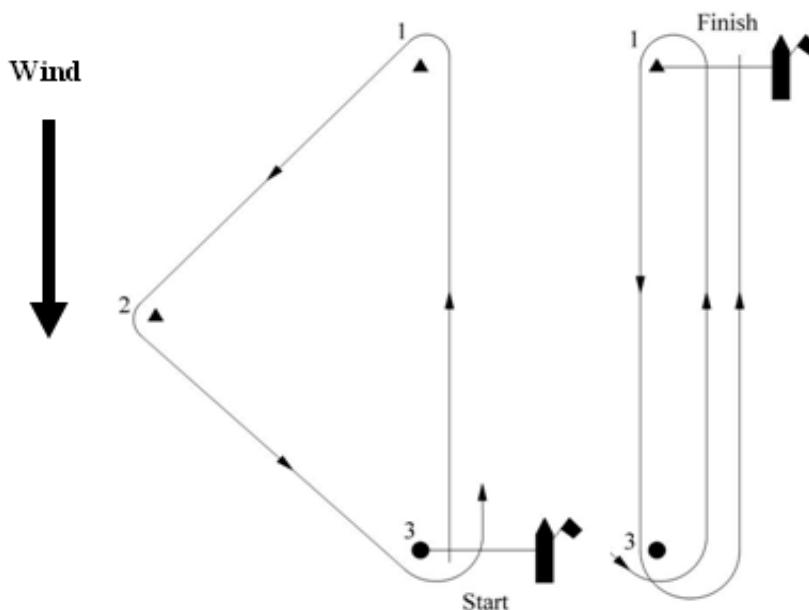


COURSE 2
